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The Great Depression, which covered the United States of America at the turn of the twenties-thirties of the last century, has become a terrible test for residents. Millions of people have lost their jobs, so they were forced to look for any ways at least somehow earn money. Others tried to bet on the crisis. Walking, for example, counterfeit. To violate the law was the elderly grower of Emerich Jutner, who, by the way, was called an honest counterfeit.

Once, in 1938, the owner of a tobacco shop in New York suffered a revenue to the bank. The cashier, while recalculating the money, drew attention to a strange bill with a par value of 1 dollar. The banknote was made of very low quality paper, the letters were written carelessly, even the President of the United States George Washington, depicted on the dollar, was little similar to himself.

The relevant services became strange fake. Soon it turned out that a similar fake dollar was far from the only thing in New York. In the hands of employees of the special services turned out to be dozens of such masterpieces. That's just found the manufacturer of such dollars for a long time failed. A criminal case was instituted at number 880, and Mister 880 began to call the mysterious fake.

It was possible to go to the trail of the criminal at all accidentally after 10 years. In one of the houses of New York, a fire broke out. Arriving firefighters were thrown from the windows of tenants, and a few days later, local policemen noticed that children living near the burnt house were played by one-dollar bills. Very similar, by the way, on those that the police turned out to be in the hands of the police.

The guards of the law managed to find out that these dollars before the fire were in the apartment of a modest Emerich Utelner, who had already collected garbage on the landfills of New York for many years. Found more or less valuable things he sold for pennies. During the Great Depression, Utelner was fired from work, and I could not find a new one because of old age. In the distant youth, Utelner came to the USA from Austria in pursuit of the American dream, but at the sunset she was a beggar.

Emery Juttner remembered that in his youth he painted well, so he decided to use these skills to earn money. At home, he built a printing machine on which he began to produce fake banknotes. Moreover, the only nominal value is 1 dollar. As he spoke later, Utnerner, he experienced conscience remorse, therefore, it was not solved for the manufacture of larger denominations.

He did not make large batches of dollars, printed exactly as much as it was necessary for a modest existence of about \$ 15 a week. In addition, he tried not to pay twice in the same store. Therefore, for a long time, Utelner managed to remain unnoticed. But, at the age of 73, he found himself on the

dock.

The court showed humanity to the old man and appointed him a punishment in the form of 1 year and 1 day of imprisonment. Plus a fine of 1 dollar. The lawyer convinced the judge that his client did not put the goal of enrichment, but simply fought for survival. For the bars of Utelner spent four months and was released early.

He returned to the modest life of a pensioner, not even suspecting that he would soon be a secured person. The thing is that this unusual history interested in Hollywood. For participation in the preparation of the scenario, Emerch Utelner received good deductions, which allowed him to live restlessness without the need. For participation in the preparation of the film, he earned more than in his entire ten-year activity of the fake-maker. At the age of 79, Emechah Utelner died in the suburb of Long Island.
